| Activity | |
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| Assigned Readings | 7 minutes per page of reading A page in an art history textbook is a 9 x 12 page, has over 600 words, 2 artworks plus captions. Reading this kind of text involves reading words but also analyzing imagery. |
| Writing | 30 minutes per page of writing |
| Technology-aided learning | 30 minutes per interactive assignment |
| Oral presentation preparation | 2 hours of prep time per 5 minutes of presentation |
| Service Learning or Civic Engagement | 8 hours per project in courses with service learning component. |
| Lab or Studio time | 10 hours of studio time per project |
| Research Papers | 45 minutes of research/reading per page of writing |
| Practicum/clinicals | 2 hours per clinical session outside of classroom |
| Study/review for Tests | 10 hours of study time per exam spread over unit of instruction—art history exams contain more than 100 works of art or architecture each of which must be identified by title, date, location, culture, school, movement, medium, artist, in addition to understanding contextual relevance and importance to the course content. Additionally, students must student terms, art historical and art process terms. In studio classes, exams are based on terminology, processes, and application of material. Exams are cumulative. Students are expected to be able to engage this content in oral critique and class discussion which required study outside class. |
| Sketchbook | 10 minutes per page, this is an average including quick gesture drawings and longer more refined drawing, as well as preparatory analysis, concept development and problem solving. |
| Architecture studio project | 6-8 hours of studio time per project component. Each of the larger projects in these courses will contain a number of assignments. Components can be research, presentation, or design-based; individual or group. |
