

Assigned readings	1000-level courses --35 minutes per 10-page section Upper-level courses: 6-7 minutes per page
Writing	1-2 hours per page
Problem sets (Online homework)	Online homework 50 minutes per section
Technology-aided learning	Watching videos/tutorials 10-15 minutes per video
Oral presentation preparation	2 hours per formal presentation
Preparation for in-class interaction	30 minutes per class period while this is assigned.
Service Learning or Civic Engagement	2 hours of engagement out of class and one hour of reflection/course engagement/reflection for every credit hour
Lab, Studio, or (music) practice time	
Research	8 hours per research project
