



Equity in Athletics Report Benedictine College Men's and Women's Intercollegiate Athletics October 11, 2023

The Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA) was designed to make prospective students and prospective student-athletes aware of an institution of higher education's commitment to providing equitable athletic opportunities for its men and women students. The EADA requires the disclosure of information about varsity teams and the financial resources and personnel that the school dedicates to those teams.

Any co-educational institution of higher education that participates in a federal student aid program must prepare an EADA report by October 15. Institutions must also report data to the U.S. Department of Education via an online survey. This is a mandatory survey.

Data collected in this survey is published by the Office of Postsecondary Education on the Equity in Athletics Data Analysis website located at <http://ope.ed.gov/athletics>. In addition, the data collected in this survey is provided by institutions in accordance with the EADA and may not be the same as data used for determining compliance with other Federal or state laws, including Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972.

The Benedictine College Intercollegiate Athletic Department offers a comprehensive program with a variety of varsity sports for both men and women.

The Ravens men's team compete in baseball, basketball, cross-country, football, soccer, indoor and outdoor track & field, lacrosse, and wrestling. The women's teams compete in basketball, cross-country, soccer, softball, spirit squad, dance, indoor and outdoor track & field, lacrosse, and volleyball.

Benedictine College is a member of the Heart of America Athletic Conference where they compete in all sports. (For lacrosse, they competed in the Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference until the 2022-2023 academic year). The college is an active member of the National Association Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), Division I.

Note: Spirit Squad and Dance figures are not included in the EADA report in the program figures since they are not a fully recognized sport according to the EADA. These two teams do compete in the Heart of America Athletic Conference the National Association Intercollegiate Athletics championships.
