Arrival and Parking:

A brick sign with the name Benedictine College marks the entrance to the campus off 2nd street. The main drive will lead you to a parking lot with reserved visitor spaces. If you are unable to secure a visitor spot, please feel free to park in any available spot.

Visitor parking is reserved in the lot labeled on the campus map as [Academic Quad North](#). Parking passes are not required for campus visitors.

Check-in:

Check-in for the Open House will be in the lower level of the [St. John Paul Student Center](#).

You will receive your detailed itinerary when you check-in. Please review the itinerary and request additional appointments to meet your needs.

Academic Session:

We have scheduled a one-hour period that will allow you to visit two academic departments. The locations and times of the sessions will be provided in the program. You may attend any of the sessions. These sessions are led by a faculty member to provide you with an overview of the curriculum and department.

This one-hour period will allow you to attend two Interest Sessions. The sessions begin at 10:00 am and 10:35 am. All sessions will be offered in both time slots.

Following Mass, please proceed to the dining hall for lunch or dinner. You will need to make this transition from St. Benedict's Abbey to the dining hall on your own. The dining hall is located on the south side of the main campus drive near the main campus entrance.
