Arrival and Parking:

A brick sign with the name Benedictine College marks the entrance to the campus off 2nd street. The main drive will lead you to a parking lot with reserved visitor spaces. If you are unable to secure a visitor spot, please feel free to park in any available spot.

Visitor parking is reserved in the lot labeled on the campus map as [Academic Quad North](#). Parking passes are not required for campus visitors.

Check-in:

Check in for the **September 20, October 4, November 22, December 6, February 17, March 2 and 27, and April 24** Raven Days will be in the lower level of the [Ferrell Academic Center](#).

Check in for the **October 25, and January 20** Raven Days will be in the lower level of the [St. John Paul Student Center](#).

You will receive your detailed itinerary when you check-in. Please review the itinerary and request additional appointments to meet your needs.

Individual Appointments with Faculty and Class Observations:

Due to the volume of visitors on Raven Days we are unable to accommodate individual appointments with faculty members and class observations.

Walking Tour:

Your visit will include a tour with a current student that lasts just under one hour. Due to time limitations and the campus visitation policy we do not include a residence hall viewing on the standard tour. However, we do schedule a separate time on your visit to view the residence halls.

Mass:

We invite you to attend Mass at 12:10 P.M. at St. Benedict's Abbey Church.

Following Mass, please proceed to the dining hall for lunch. You will need to make the transition from St. Benedict's Abbey to the dining hall on your own. The dining hall is located on the south side of the campus drive near the main campus entrance.

We contract with Aramark, a national leader in dining, for our meal services and they are equipped to prepare meals for all dietary needs.

Overnight guests are assigned to a current student based on student availability. You will meet your host at the conclusion of your visit.

Overnight guests are encouraged to bring a sleeping bag, pillow, towel, and all personal toiletries. Our student hosts do not have an extra mattress so you may sleep on a couch or futon.
